Agenda Item #3: Scheduling

- Before going through the assigned sections, page by page, Erika discussed several topics that have been raised by members of the Subcommittee:
 - Electric Vehicles as a tool: This topic had been omitted from the draft because it appeared that there was little chance for this tool to be effective. However, is now appear there has been a palette established for Electric Vehicles and they will be included in the plan.
 - Health as an objective, vis-à-vis parks, open space, trails and bike paths, will have a place in the plan as well. That is, “Public Health” will now be elevated to a policy issue.
 - Roadway Classification System: Details of the Roadway Classification System will be removed from the main body of the plan and attached as an Appendix.
 - Tools: It had been noted by members of the Subcommittee, that many of the tools suggested by the public and other GVPAC members did not seem to be included in the plan. Erika noted that it was important to choose the

“right tools”, that is, pick those that are the most feasible (cost, difficulty etc.) and likely to be accomplished.
