1. Welcome and Participant Introductions

The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:30 pm and Facilitator John Jostes led the group introductions. .

The meeting notes from July 12th were reviewed and adopted with minor corrections.

The GVC decided to schedule two meetings on Thursday, August 3, and Tuesday, August 8, 2006 to discuss the forthcoming Management of Growth section and provide direction to the writing sub-committee.

2. Initial Public Comment Period

Mary Whalen and Ann Crosby provided input to the group.

3. Staff & Writing Sub-Committee Presentation -Infrastructure

Hal Hill and Lauren Hanson, writing sub-committee members provided an overview of the draft infrastructure section since they were instrumental in crafting the section. Eva Inbar recommended that the chapter reflect, in her opinion, a more accurate assessment of the roads, the impact of Measure D in elevating service levels and the challenges and hard work of County Public Works. Comments from the GVC would be incorporated into the revised draft.

4. Staff & Writing Sub-Committee Presentation –Public Safety

The GVC initiated the same process of review as the infrastructure section. Ted Adams led the discussion due to his extensive experience working with OES, Fire and the Sheriff's Department and guidance on the writing sub-committee. The group discussed applying the same types of public safety standards throughout the planning area and not limit the standards to the mountainous areas. Eva Inbar suggested that a goal be added to address safe streets. Supervisor Rose commented that the greatest number of calls that her office receives is with respect to concerns about public street safety and speeding vehicles. Comments from the GVC would be incorporated into the revised draft.

5. Staff & Writing Sub-Committee Presentation –Governance

Valerie Olson led the discussion because of her insight and critical role in drafting the section. Unfortunately, a incorrect version was distributed on the web which hampered the discussion. It was agreed that a portion of the document would be moved to the Management of Growth section.
