1. **Meeting Called to Order:** By Chair, Chris Wrather at 6:30 p.m.

Rosie Dyste introduced the purpose of the meeting to attendees as the first in a series of two meetings for the LAPAC to review and approve the Los Alamos Pedestrian Circulation and Parking conceptual plans.

2. **Public Comment for Items not on the Agenda:**

Stephen McLendon discussed commercial building colors and lighting in reference to the Los Alamos Bell Street Design Guidelines.

Chris Wrather commented as a member of the community on the issue of alcohol regulation and his intention to bring the issue to Supervisor Farr for her consideration.

No other comments were received.

3. **Los Alamos Pedestrian Circulation and Parking Plan**

Rosie Dyste introduced the project team and reviewed the purpose and major tasks of the project. Ms. Dyste discussed the results of community surveys, the two public workshops, and the Central Board of Architectural Review (CBAR) comments.

James Powell reviewed the new exhibits that were prepared after the CBAR comments (distributed with the LAPAC meeting packets and available on the project webpage). At the discretion of the Chair, the LAPAC and the public asked technical questions and made comments throughout the presentation.

Public Comment Period

Chair Wrather opened the public comment period on the Los Alamos Pedestrian Circulation and Parking Plan. Most attendees that had filled out speaker slips had already had expressed their questions and/or had their comments addressed.

4. LAPAC Administrative Tasks: Report from Staff and LAPAC Chair

Mr. Wrather briefed the LAPAC and the public regarding the water availability study for the San Antonio Groundwater Basin and provided a webpage address for project updates.

Ms. Dyste briefed the LAPAC and the public on the Rosemary Commons project that was recently built and the Sagebrush Junction project that is in the permit process.

5. Next Steps

Ms. Dyste discussed the next steps for the Los Alamos Pedestrian and Parking Plan and a meeting date in September 2014 for the second LAPAC meeting on this topic.

ACTION: A motion was made by Naughton and seconded by Mortholé to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried by a vote of 5-0.
