

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

IN THE MATTER OF REQUESTING THAT THE COASTAL)
COMMISSION GRANT A 90-DAY EXTENSION OF TIME)
FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF PRC §30600.5(b))
WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE DELEGATION OF COASTAL)
DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AUTHORITY TO THE COUNTY)
ON APRIL 30, 1982 FOR CERTAIN DEVELOPMENTS)
IN THE COASTAL ZONE.)

RESOLUTION NO. 82-151

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

A. On January 1, 1982, Public Resources Code §30600.5 became effective. Under this section, the authority for the issuance of Coastal Development Permits for certain specified developments shall be delegated to local governments prior to April 30, 1982.

B. Pursuant to PRC §30600.5, local governments must prepare and provide the executive director of the Coastal Commission drafts of all procedures for the issuance of Coastal Development Permits. These procedures must contain minimum standards for notice, hearing and appeal procedures adopted by the Coastal Commission and must be adopted by an interim ordinance.

C. Public Resources Code §30600.5(h) provides that the 120 day time limits set forth in this section shall be extended by right, for not more than 90 days, if a local government adopts a resolution requesting such an extension.

D. Because preparing and adopting these interim permit procedures requires substantial amount of staff time and because it is anticipated the County's Local Coastal Plan will receive final certification during this interim period, which would eliminate the need to prepare these procedures, it is not in the County's best interest to assume authority for the issuance of Coastal Development Permits on April 30, 1982. Therefore, pursuant to PRC §30600.5(h), the County requests a 90 day extension of time from the requirements of PRC §30600(b).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. The Board hereby requests that, pursuant to Public Resources Code §30600.5(h), the 120 day time limits set forth in Public Resources Code §30600.5(b) be extended for 90 days to July 29, 1982.






