15 WHEREAS major oil storage facilities will be required to support
16 an oil transportation system in Santa Barbara County; and

17 WHEREAS such a transportation system may consist of one or more
18 pipelines, marine terminals or other facilities; and

19 WHEREAS the County wishes to ensure that such oil storage
20 facilities are consolidated; and

21 WHEREAS such oil storage facilities should be located in the
22 least environmentally damaging location;

23 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS, HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

24 A. The Board of Supervisors hereby adopts, in concept,
25 amendments to the County Local Coastal Plan and Coastal Zoning Ordinance
26 as described in Attachment A to this Resolution.
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B. The County LCP, Comprehensive Plan and zoning ordinances shall be interpreted and implemented pursuant to these clarifications and guidelines to the maximum extent possible.


