SENSITIVE HABITAT OVERLAY DESIGNATION)

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan and Zoning to be consistent with the Coastal Plan.
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. It is now deemed to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County that the Board of Supervisors amend the Local Coastal Program to amend the Land Use Designation for APNs 073-120-015 and -016 (approximately 34.4 acres) located on the east and west sides of Los Carneros Road approximately 500 feet north of its intersection with Mesa Road from Educational Facility to Open Lands with an Environmentally Sensitive Habitat Overlay Designation.
- D. The Planning Commission of Santa Barbara County, after holding a duly noticed public hearing on the above-described item, has endorsed and transmitted to this Board said recommended changes, in Resolution No. 92-6, pursuant to Government Code Section 65354.
- E. Public Officials and agencies, civic organizations and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Board of Supervisors on the proposed amendment in a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- F. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed amendment, pursuant to Government Code Section 65355, at which hearing the amendment was explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
- G. This amendment to the Local Coastal Program is consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976, as amended to this date.
- HG. The Board now wishes to submit this amendment to the California Coastal

Commission for certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 65356 and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above-described change is hereby adopted as an amendment to the Coastal Land Use Plan of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan.
3. This Board certifies that this amendment is intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act.
4. This Board submits this amendment to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
5. The Chairman and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents, and other material in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above-described actions.
