

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

IN THE MATTER OF SUBMITTING TO THE) RESOLUTION NO. 92-699
COASTAL COMMISSION AMENDMENTS TO THE) CASE NOs 92-GP-15, 92-OA-15
VARIOUS MAPS AND TEXTS OF THE SANTA) 92-OA-20, 92-RZ-16, 91-OA-1,
BARBARA COUNTY LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM.) 91-RZ-5, 92-OA-10, 92-OA-21

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan; and
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312. the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. It being deemed to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County, the Board of Supervisors has amended the Local Coastal Program as specified below.
 - 1. (92-GP-015) Adopt amendments to the Local Coastal Plan to incorporate the Montecito Community Plan.
 - 2. (92-OA-015) Adopt the Montecito Community Plan zoning map into Article II as well as add the 5-E-1 zone district to Article II.
 - 3. (92-OA-020) Adopt the Montecito Community Plan Overlay District into Article II.
 - 4. (92-RZ-016) Adopt the Montecito Community Plan Article II Coastal Zoning Map, Coastal Zoning Overlay Map and ESH Overlay Map into Article II.
 - 5. (91-OA-001) Amend Article II to clarify and streamline the development permit process for public/private works projects.
 - 6. (91-RZ-005) Rezone APN 079-090-029 from 3-E-1 to PI, Professional Institutional under Article II.
 - 7. (92-OA-010) Amend Article II to clarify and streamline the permit process.

8. (92-OA-021) Amend Article II to clarify and streamline the permit process.
- D. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- E. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendment(s) was/were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
- F. These amendments to the Local Coastal Program are consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976.
- G. The Board now wishes to submit these amendments to the California Coastal Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65356 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan and Coastal Zoning Ordinance text.
3. This Board certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the said California Coastal Act.
4. The Board submits these Local Coastal Plan amendments to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
5. The Chairman and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board of Supervisors.
