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WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan; and
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. The Board of Supervisors, having deemed it to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County, has amended the Local Coastal Program as specified below.
1. (90-GP-017 and 90-OA-025) Adopted amendments to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program Regarding Transportation Corridor Land Use Designation and Zone District by Resolution No. 93-218 and Ordinance 4093 (attached).
  2. (92-GP-003, 92-GP-004, 92-GP-005, 92-RZ-005, 92-RZ-006, and 92-RZ-007) Adopted amendments to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program Regarding application of Transportation Corridor Land Use Designation and Zone District by Resolution No. 92-313 and Ordinance No. 4044 (attached).
  3. (89-SP-002) Adopted amendments to the County Local Coastal Program to adopt the Ellwood Beach/Santa Barbara Shores Specific Plan by Resolution No. 93-363 (attached).
  4. (92-GP-25) Approved specific amendments to the Coastal Land Use Plan of Santa Barbara County associated with adoption of the Goleta Community Plan by Resolution No. 93-402 (attached).

5. (92-OA-28, 93-GP-01) Adopted amendments to Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code to implement the Goleta Community Plan by amending Division 1 (In General) to amend the Goleta Coastal Plan Zoning Map and Overlay; amending Division 1 (in General) and Division 4 (Zoning Districts) to add a C-1-GOL (Limited Commercial-Goleta) zone district and a M-S-GOL (Service Industrial - Goleta) zone district; amending Division 1 (In General) and Division 5 (Overlay Districts) to add an AH-GOL (Affordable Housing-Goleta) overlay district; amending existing Division 14 to renumber as Division 15; and adding a new Division 14 (Goleta Community Plan Overlay) by Ordinance No. 4110 and Resolution No. 93-403(attached).
  6. (92-RZ-024, 93-GP-01) Adopted amendments to Section 35-54, Adopting New Zoning Ordinances and Maps and Uncertainties in District Boundaries of Article II of Chapter 35 of the Code of Santa Barbara, California, by adopting by reference four zoning maps, identified as Board of Supervisors exhibits nos. 35-54.7.8, 35-54.20.0, 35-54.21.0, and 35-54.22.0, to rezone certain parcels to implement the Goleta Community Plan and to remove Goleta from existing maps by Ordinance No. 4110 and Resolution No. 93-403 (attached).
  7. (90-OA-03) Adopted amendments to Section 35-177, Reclamation Plans and Surface Mining Permits, of Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code by Ordinance No. 4096 (attached).
  8. (90-OA-04) Adopted amendments to Section 35-69-3.9 of the Agriculture II zoning district of Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code concerning excavation and quarrying of building and construction materials by Ordinance No. 4097 (attached).
  9. (83-GP-12; 83-RZ-15) Resubmission of Resolution No. 88-421 and Ordinance 3762 adopting a Land Use Designation and Zoning Ordinance amendment for Haskell's Beach property.
- D. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in duly noticed public hearings pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- E. This Board has held duly noticed public hearings, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearings the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
- F. These amendments to the Local Coastal Program are consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976.

G. The Board now wishes to submit these amendments to the California Coastal Commission, and requests that each Amendment contained within be considered independently for determination of completeness, processing, and final action by the Commission so as to expedite certification and implementation where possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65356 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes have been adopted as amendments to the Santa Barbara County Local Coastal Program.
3. This Board certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the said California Coastal Act.
4. The Board submits these Local Coastal Program amendments to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
5. The Chairman and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board of Supervisors.
