WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan.
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code.
- C. The Board of Supervisors, having deemed it to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County, has amended the Local Coastal Program as specified below:
  1. **94-OA-016:** Adopt Ordinance amendments to Article II text incorporating flexible unit size and parking standards as incentives for legalizing existing illegal second units.
  2. **94-OA-05:** Adopt Ordinance amendments to Article II text in order to implement the Montecito Architectural and Design Guidelines.
  3. **94-GP-009:** Approve an amendment to the Circulation Component of the Summerland Community Plan and the Coastal Land Use Plan of the Local Coastal Program providing an exemption for Affordable Housing Overlay project sites and special needs facilities from roadway and intersection standards.
  4. **94-GP-008:** Approve an amendment to the Circulation Component of the Montecito Community Plan and the Coastal Land Use Plan of the Local Coastal Program providing an exemption for Affordable Housing Overlay project sites and special needs facilities from roadway and intersection standards.

5. **94-GP-007:** Approve an amendment to the Circulation Component of the Goleta Community Plan and the Coastal Land Use Plan of the Local Coastal Program providing an exemption for Affordable Housing Overlay project sites and special needs facilities from roadway and intersection standards.
  6. **94-GP-15:** Approve amendments to the Local Coastal Program to implement amendments to Parks, Recreation, and Trails Map (PRT-3), and policy amendments to the Goleta Community Plan Land Use Element.
  7. **94-GP-17:** Approve amendments to the Local Coastal Plan to implement amendments to the Goleta Community Plan Circulation Element regarding the Goleta Bikeways Element Map.
- C. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- D. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:


1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65356 of the Government Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Land Use Element of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan.
3. The Chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 65357 the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to send endorsed copies of said maps to the planning agency of each city within this County.
