

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan; and
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. On July 20, 1993, by Resolution No. 93-403, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Goleta Community Plan update to the Coastal Land Use Plan.
- D. In June 1994, the California Coastal Commission certified the Goleta Community Plan as part of the County's Local Coastal Program.
- E. On October 12, 1995, the California Coastal Commission certified the revised trail locations identified in the Goleta Trails Implementation Study as the new Parks, Recreation and Trails Map for the Goleta Community Plan area.
- F. LUDS-GV-3 of the Coastal Land Use Plan requires that a Specific Plan be prepared for the entire Ellwood Beach-Santa Barbara Shores site prior to County's acceptance of any applications for development.
- G. Article II, the Coastal Zoning Ordinance, §35-175 provides that the Board of Supervisors adopt the Specific Plan as part of the Coastal Land Use Plan.

- H. On June 29, 1993 the Board of Supervisors approved a Specific Plan and submitted this plan to the Coastal Commission. On January 12, 1994 the Coastal Commission rejected the Specific Plan, but continued the hearing for consideration of suggested modifications. On August 10, 1994, the Coastal Commission certified the Specific Plan with suggested modifications and instructed the County on acceptance procedures.
- I. On October 4, 1994, the Board of Supervisors approved a revised Specific Plan and resubmitted this plan to the Coastal Commission. The resubmitted plan was pending before the Coastal Commission for action at the Coastal Commission's February 1995 hearing.
- J. On February 7, 1995, the Board of Supervisors approved the Ellwood Beach-Santa Barbara Shores Specific Plan (89-SP-002), with suggested modifications by the Coastal Commission on August 10, 1994 and took conceptual action to withdraw the pending October 1994 resubmittal; amend the Specific Plan in response to the Coastal Commission's August 1994 certification with suggested modifications by incorporating all of the Coastal Commission's suggested modifications and making text revisions; and adopt revised Findings, CEQA Addendum, and Specific Plan documents pursuant to Coastal Commission regulations §13544.
- K. In June 1995, the Coastal Commission approved the Specific Plan as submitted.
- L. It is now deemed to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County that the Board of Supervisors amend the Local Coastal Program as specified below:
  - 1. Amend the Parks, Recreation and Trails map for the Goleta Community Plan area (PRT-3):
    - a. Modify the location of the eastern coastal access trail on the SBDP property and add the Coronado Drive trail link. (Attachment K to the Planning Commission Action Letter of August 7, 1997).
  - 2. Amend Goleta Community Plan component:
    - a. Amend the trail maps referenced in the Plan to reflect the Ellwood Beach portion of the revised PRT-3 map which is located within the boundaries of the Goleta Community Plan (Attachment K to the Planning Commission Action Letter of August 7, 1997).
    - b. Amend Goleta Community Plan site specific Development Standards LUDS-GV-3.1, 3.4, 3.5, 3.8, 3.10, 3.11, and 3.12 (Attachment C to the Planning Commission Action Letter of August 7, 1997).
  - 3. Amend the Ellwood Beach - Santa Barbara Shores Specific Plan (89-SP-002 RV02: including the general text, development standards and figures identified in

the March 1997 Specific Plan as amended by Attachment D to the Planning Commission Action Letter of August 7, 1997.

- F. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Sections 65353 and 65854 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Sections 65354 and 65855 of the Government Code.
- G. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Sections 65355 and 65856 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendment(s) was/were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
- H. These amendments to the Local Coastal Program are consistent with the provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976.
- I. The Board now wishes to submit these amendments to the California Coastal Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 65356 and 65857 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Local Coastal Program.
3. This Board certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out as a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act.
4. The Board shall submit these Local Coastal Program Amendments to the California Coastal Commission for review and certification.
5. The Chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board.






