WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On January 7, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-12, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan; and
- B. On July 19, 1982, by Ordinance 3312, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Santa Barbara County Coastal Zoning Ordinance, Article II of Chapter 35 of the Santa Barbara County Code; and
- C. On May 19, 1992 by Resolution No. 92-309, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Summerland Community Plan update to the Coastal Land Use Plan; and
- D. In October 1992, the California Coastal Commission certified the Summerland Community Plan as part of the County's Local Coastal Program.
- E. On July 20, 1993, by Resolution No. 93-403, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Goleta Community Plan update to the Coastal Land Use Plan.
- F. In June 1994, the California Coastal Commission certified the Goleta Community Plan as part of the County's Local Coastal Program.
- G. On October 12, 1995, the California Coastal Commission certified the revised trail locations identified in the Goleta Trails Implementation Study as the new Parks, Recreation and Trails Map for the Goleta Community Plan area.
- H. On March 28, 1995, by Resolution No. 95-138, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Goleta Transportation Improvement Plan (GTIP)
- I. It is now deemed to be in the interest of orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety , and general welfare of the residents of said County that the Board of Supervisors amend the Local Coastal Program specified below.

Greenwell Park:

- 1. **96-GP-009**, amend the Santa Barbara County Coastal Land Use Plan by changing the designation of APN 005-080-004 from Institution/Government Facility to Existing Public or Private Recreational and/or Open Space.

2. **96-RZ-009**, rezone AP No. 005-080-004 from Rural Residential (RR-5) to Recreation.

Monarch Point Reserve:

1. **97-GP-003**, amend the Parks, Recreation and Trails map for the Goleta Community Plan area (PRT-3).
 - a. Modify the location of the eastern coastal access trail on the SBDP property and add the Coronado Drive trail link (Attachment K to the 8/6/97 staff memo to the Planning Commission).
2. **97-GP-003**, amend Goleta Community Plan component:
 - a. Amend the trail maps referenced in the Plan to reflect the Ellwood Beach portion of the revised PRT-3 map which is located within the boundaries of the Goleta Community Plan (Attachment K to the 8/6/97 staff memo to the Planning Commission);
 - b. Amend Goleta Community Plan site specific Development Standards LUDS-GV-3.1, 3.4, 3.5, 3.8, 3.10, 3.11, and 3.12 (Attachment C to the 7/7/97 staff memo to the Planning Commission).
3. **89-SP-002 RV02**, amend the Ellwood Beach - Santa Barbara Shores Specific Plan including the general text, development standards and figures identified in the March 1997 Specific Plan as amended by Attachment D to the 7/7/97 staff memo to the Planning Commission and the errata dated 8/6/97.

Goleta Transportation Improvement Plan:

97-GP-007, amend the Goleta Community Plan Circulation Element to add policies, actions and development standards (as amended) to the Goleta Community Plan Circulation Element. (Attachments 1&3 of staff report for Planning Commission Hearing of May 21, 1997, hereby incorporated by reference.)

- J. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- K. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendment(s) was/were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.
- L. These amendments to the Local Coastal Program are consistent with provisions of the Coastal Act of 1976.
- M. The Board now wishes to submit these amendments to the California Coastal Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:


1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 65356 and 65857 of the Government Code and Section 30514 of the Public Resources Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Santa Barbara County Coastal Plan and Coastal Zoning Ordinance text and maps.
3. This Board certifies that these amendments are intended to be carried out in a manner fully in conformity with the California Coastal Act.
4. The Board submits these Local Coastal Program amendments to the California Coastal Commission for approval and certification without modification pursuant to Coastal Commission Administrative Regulation § 13551(b)(1), which provides that these amendments take effect immediately. The Board hereby resolves, for purposes of § 13544(a) of Title 14, Cal. Code of Regulations that, in the event the Coastal Commission certifies any of the components of the LCP amendment package adopted and submitted to the Commission without making any suggestions for changes or modifications thereto (i.e., as submitted by the County), the Board shall be deemed to have 1) acknowledged receipt of the Coastal Commission's resolution of certification, and 2) agreed to issue coastal development permits in accordance therewith for the total area included in the County's certified LCP.
5. The Board hereby delegates its authority to communicate its acknowledgment of receipt of the Commission's Resolution of Certification to the Director of the County's Planning and Development Department.
6. The Chairman and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board of Supervisors.
