RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

A. On December 22, 1980, by Resolution No.80-566, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Comprehensive Plan Circulation Element for the County of Santa Barbara.

B. When the Planning Commission initiated the Community Plan Updates, they were to amend both the Land Use and Circulation Elements concurrently to make sure these two Elements were in balance.

C. It is now deemed in the interest of the orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of the County to adopt the following amendments to the Circulation Element of the Comprehensive Plan, as follows:

1. Amend the Circulation Element by adding the following language to Section V of the Circulation Element:

V CIRCULATION ELEMENT POLICIES

- A. The roadway classifications, intersection levels of service, and capacity levels adopted in this Element shall apply to all roadways and intersections within

the unincorporated area of the County, with the exception of those roadways and intersections located within an area included in an adopted community or area plan. Roadway classifications, intersection levels of service, and capacity levels adopted as part of any community or area plan subsequent to the adoption of this Element shall supersede any standards included as part of this Element.

1. For the community of Summerland, please see the Circulation chapter of the Summerland Community Plan sections of the Coastal Land Use Plan and the Land Use Element of the Comprehensive Plan for the specific Policies and Actions which implement this policy

2. Amend the "Montecito/Summerland Circulation Map" (CIRC 8) to separate the Summerland Planning Area from that map and create a new Summerland Circulation Map which shall reflect the new Circulation Element adopted classifications for roadways within the Summerland Planning Area.

C. Public officials and agencies, the Summerland Advisory Committee, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted and have advised the Planning Commission on said proposed amendments in public hearings pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.

D. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 65356, the above-described

change in the Comprehensive Plan is hereby adopted as an amendment to the above mentioned Plan Text and Maps.

3. Pursuant to the provision of Government Code Section 65357, the Chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents, and other material in accordance with this Resolution to show the above-mentioned action by the Board.
