RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING SPECIFIC)
AMENDMENTS TO THE CIRCULATION)RESOLUTION 94-97
ELEMENT OF THE SANTA BARBARA)CASE NO. 92-GP-23
COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN)

WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On December 20, 1980 , by Resolution No 80-566, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted the Comprehensive Plan Circulation Element for the County of Santa Barbara.
- B. Circulation Element Policies A and B anticipated that, as part of the Community Plan updates, the Land Use and Circulation Elements were to be amended concurrently to ensure that they are in balance.
- C. It is now deemed in the interest of the orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County to make the following amendments to the Circulation Element of the County's Comprehensive Plan:
 1. Amend Section V.A. of the Circulation Element to add subsection 2. as follows:
 2. For the community of Los Alamos, please see the Circulation chapter of the Los Alamos Community Plan section of the Comprehensive Plan's Land Use Element for specific policies and actions that implement this policy.
 2. Adopt by reference the Los Alamos Community Plan Circulation Element Map dated 2/8/94 , which reflects the new Circulation Element adopted classifications for roadways within the Los Alamos Planning Area.
 3. Delete CIRC-8 (Los Alamos Area Circulation Map) which is to be replaced by the above mentioned Los Alamos Community Plan Circulation Element Map.
- C. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- D. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65356 of the Government Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Circulation Element of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan.
3. The Chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board.
4. Pursuant to the Provisions of Government Code Section 65357 the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to send endorsed copies of said maps to the planning agency of each city within this County.


