WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- A. On December 20, 1980, by Resolution No. 80-566, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara adopted a Comprehensive Plan Land Use Element for the County of Santa Barbara which included text and designations for lands within the jurisdiction of Santa Barbara County.
- B. It is now deemed in the interest of the orderly development of the County and important to the preservation of the health, safety, and general welfare of the residents of said County to adopt an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan Land Use Element for the Santa Ynez area (COMP-4) to change the land use designation of APN 137-100-030 from A-1-5 to Residential, one dwelling unit per acre maximum; an amendment to the Land Use Element for the Orcutt area (COMP-6) to change the land use designation of APN 111-250-018, -055, -056, and -057 from Residential, 1.0 unit per acre to Residential, 1.8 units per acre; and, an amendment to change Figure E-1, Conceptual Diagram for Internal Circulation Network, in the Land Use Element, p. 126-c, and a change to Development Standard "d", page 126-b, to read "Future development within this area shall be consistent with the internal circulation network plan developed in 86-EIR-5, as such plan may be amended from time to time.
- C. Public officials and agencies, civic organizations, and citizens have been consulted on and have advised the Planning Commission on the said proposed amendments in a public hearing pursuant to Section 65353 of the Government Code, and the Planning Commission has sent its written recommendations to the Board pursuant to Section 65354 of the Government Code.
- D. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing, as required by Section 65355 of the Government Code, on the proposed amendments, at which hearing the amendments were explained and comments invited from the persons in attendance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:


1. The above recitations are true and correct.
2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65356 of the Government Code, the above described changes are hereby adopted as amendments to the Land Use Element of the Santa Barbara County Comprehensive Plan.
3. Pursuant to the provision of Government Code Section 65357, the chair and the Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to sign and certify all maps, documents and other materials in accordance with this Resolution to reflect the above described action by the Board.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 65357 the Clerk of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to send endorsed copies of said COMP-4 and -6 maps to the planning agency of each city within this County.
