

1 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
2 COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

10 WITH REFERENCE TO THE FOLLOWING:

11 A. On August 17, 1965, by Resolution No. 24908, this
12 Board of Supervisors adopted a General Plan for the entire county,
13 which included a General Plan Report, a book containing 155 pages
14 of text and designated as Exhibit GP-10.

15 B. In 1971 and 1972, the Legislature of the State of
16 California added a Seismic Safety Element to the list of the
17 mandatory elements required in all general plans, as provided in
18 Gov't.C. § 65302(f).

19 C. In 1975, the Legislature of the State of California
20 added a Safety Element to the list of the mandatory elements
21 required in all general plans, as provided in Govt'.C. § 65302(i).

22 D. A Seismic Safety Element is defined in Gov't.C. §
23 65302(f):

24 "A seismic safety element consisting of an
25 identification and appraisal of seismic hazards such
26 as susceptibility to surface ruptures from faulting,
27 to ground shaking, to ground failures, or to effects
28 of seismically induced waves such as tsunamis and
29 seiches.

30 "The seismic safety element shall also include an
31 appraisal of mudslides, landslides, and slope stabil-
32 ity as necessary geologic hazards that must be con-
sidered simultaneously with other hazards such as
possible surface ruptures from faulting, ground
shaking, ground failure and seismically induced waves."

33 E. A Safety Element is defined in Gov't.C. § 65302(i):

"A safety element for the protection of the
community from fires and geologic hazards including
features necessary for such protection as evacuation
routes, peak load water supply requirements, minimum
road widths, clearances around structures, and geologic
hazard mapping in areas of known geologic hazards."

1 F. It is now deemed in the interest of the orderly develop-
2 ment of the County and important to the preservation of the health,
3 safety, and general welfare of the residents of the County to adopt
4 a combined Seismic Safety and Safety Element consisting of 214 pages
5 of text and additional maps interspered between the pages of text.

6 G. The Planning Commission of the County of Santa Barbara,
7 after holding a duly noticed public hearing on the said combined
8 Seismic Safety and Safety Element as required by Section 65351 of
9 the Government Code, approved, endorsed, and transmitted to this
10 Board said recommended element by its Resolution No. 78-62.

11 H. This Board has held a duly noticed public hearing on
12 the above-described combined element, as required by Section 65355
13 of the Government Code.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED as follows:

15 1. The above recitations are true and correct.

16 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 65357 of the
17 Government Code, the above-described text and additional maps
18 entitled "Seismic Safety and Safety Element" is adopted as an
19 element of the Santa Barbara County General Plan.

20 3. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section
21 65359, the Chairman and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized
22 and directed to endorse said element to show that said element has
23 been adopted by this Board.

24 4. Pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section
25 65360, the Clerk of this Board is hereby authorized and directed
26 to send endorsed copies of said element to the planning agency of
27 each city within this County.


