8 COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA WHICH WOULD )  
9 AMEND THE TEXT OF THE SEISMIC SAFETY )  
10 AND SAFETY ELEMENT BY CHANGING THE )  
11 TITLE OF SECTION VI "FIRE HAZARD" TO )  
12 "FIRE HAZARD AND FIRE SERVICES," AND )  
13 ADD A POLICY REGARDING FUNDING FOR )  
14 FIRE FACILITIES NEEDED TO SERVE NEW )  
15 DEVELOPMENT. )

16 With reference to the following:

17 A. On January 22, 1979, by Resolution No. 79-43A this  
18 Board adopted the Seismic Safety and Safety Element of the  
19 Comprehensive (General) Plan for the County of Santa Barbara.

20 B. It is now deemed in the public interest to  
21 initiate the following changes to the Seismic Safety and Safety  
22 Element:

23 1. To change the title of Section VI "Fire  
24 Hazard" to read "Fire Hazard and Fire Services."

25 2. To add a policy entitled "Funding For Fire  
26 Facilities to Serve New Development" to Section VI, FIRE HAZARD  
27 AND FIRE SERVICES of the Seismic Safety and Safety Element. The  
28 Board of Supervisors and the Planning Commission will consider  
an amendment authorizing the Fire Chiefs of the Santa Barbara  
County Fire Department and of other Fire Districts in the County  
of Santa Barbara to identify needs for new and improved fire  
service facilities for each area in the County, and to project  
the needs for facilities to serve proposed and

1 potential new development. The Board of Supervisors and the  
2 Planning Commission will consider an amendment authorizing the  
3 Board of Supervisors to approve such statement of identification  
4 of need, and after the Board of Supervisors approval, the  
5 amendment would authorize either the Board of Supervisors or the  
6 Planning Commission to condition discretionary land use permits  
7 on the payment of fees calculated to provide the cost of  
8 financing new and improved fire facilities identified as needed  
9 to serve new development.

10 C. The Planning Commission of the County of Santa  
11 Barbara is directed to report on the proposed amendment pursuant  
12 to Gov. Code § 65356.1, after holding a duly noticed public  
13 hearing.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

  - 17 2. Pursuant to the provisions of Gov. Code § 65356.1,  
18 the above described amendment to the Seismic Safety and Safety  
19 Element of the Comprehensive (General) Plan of the County of  
20 Santa Barbara is initiated for adoption as an amendment to the  
21 Comprehensive Plan. The motion for initiation of the amendment  
22 was passed by the following vote:




