The Santa Barbara County Planning Commission will hold a hearing to review and consider making a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors regarding proposed changes to the County's 2003-2008 Housing Element, including implementation of the Focused Rezone Program. The Focused Rezone Program is designed to comply with the California Department of Housing and Community Development (State HCD) requirements to demonstrate that capacity additional housing capacity has been made available to meet the targets established for the County by State HCD for the 2001-2009 Regional Housing Needs Allocation period (RHNA). Completion of the program is necessary in order for the County to maintain certification of the Housing Element

The Focused Rezone Program proposes to amend the existing zoning for two sites to accommodate a minimum of 372 units of multifamily housing. Portions of two sites identified in the Orcutt Community Plan as Key Site 3 and 30 can accommodate 372 units of affordable multifamily housing on a combined 18.6 acres and were evaluated, along with several alternatives, in an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) commissioned by the County this summer.
