**Housing Element Focused Rezone Program  
Draft Environmental Impact Report  
Public Comment Period Ends September 19, 2008 at 5p.m.**

The Santa Barbara County Planning and Development Department, Office of Long Range Planning, serving as Lead Agency, has completed a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the 2003-2008 Housing Element Focused Rezone Program. The 2003-2008 Housing Element Focused Rezone Program proposes to amend the existing zoning for two sites to accommodate a minimum of 370 units of multifamily housing. Portions of two sites identified in the Orcutt Community Plan as Key Site 3 and 30 can accommodate 372 units of affordable multifamily housing on a combined 18.6 acres. Five sites located in Orcutt and Vandenberg Village/Mission Hills will be analyzed as alternatives. This program is being proposed in order to comply with the California Department of Housing and Community Development (State HCD) requirements to demonstrate the capacity to provide additional affordable housing opportunities and is necessary to maintain certification of the 2003-2008 Housing Element. Significant effects on the environment are anticipated in the following areas:  
**Land Use, Public Services, Traffic and Circulation, Biological Resources, Air Quality, Fire Hazards, Noise, Water, Cultural Resources, Visual and Aesthetic Resources.**
